



Naples company to manage Fort Myers marina

BoatClubsAmerica, a Naples-based developer of marinas across the state, has announced an agreement with MariTech Services Inc. to manage the boat yard and marine services operations at the Fort Myers BoatClub, at 14070 McGregor Blvd.

The Fort Myers BoatClub is a 26-acre marina off the Caloosahatchee River. The Fort Myers BoatClub is being redeveloped to include 343 boathouse spaces and 90 floating boat slips sold as condominium units.

"After MariTech Services' success at the Ft. Lauderdale BoatClub, it was only natural to bring them in to manage the Fort Myers BoatClub," said Ed Ruff, president of BoatClubsAmerica, in a statement.

MariTech Services is owned by G. Robert Toney. Since 1993, Toney has owned National Liquidators, a vessel recovery company and boat auction. He also operates several other marine-related companies.
