Prior to this position, Amata served as National Liquidator's director of client development. He has been with the company since 2001.

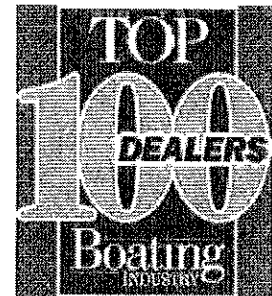
Michael Bacchiocchi has joined the company as vice president of operations and finance. He will oversee the company's procedures and finance policies to make improvements for the increased business.
